

N11 Abbreviated Dialing Codes

Abbreviated dialing codes enable callers to connect to a location in the phone network that otherwise would be accessible only via ten-digit telephone number.

The following are existing N11 code Federal Communications Commission (FCC) assignments:

211:	Used across the Southern Linc footprint for community information and referral services
311:	Operational for cities of Birmingham, Montgomery and Tuscaloosa, AL for non-emergency and other government services
411:	Used virtually nationwide for directory assistance
511:	Used in Southern Linc's Florida and Georgia coverage areas for traffic and transportation information
611:	Used across the Southern Linc footprint for Customer Solutions
711:	Used across the Southern Linc footprint for Telecom Relay Services (Hearing Impaired Services)
811:	Used across the Southern Linc footprint for state One Call Notification Centers (Call before you dig)
911:	Used across the Southern Linc footprint for emergency services (e.g. fire, police, ambulance, etc.)
988:	Used across the Southern Linc footprint for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline
