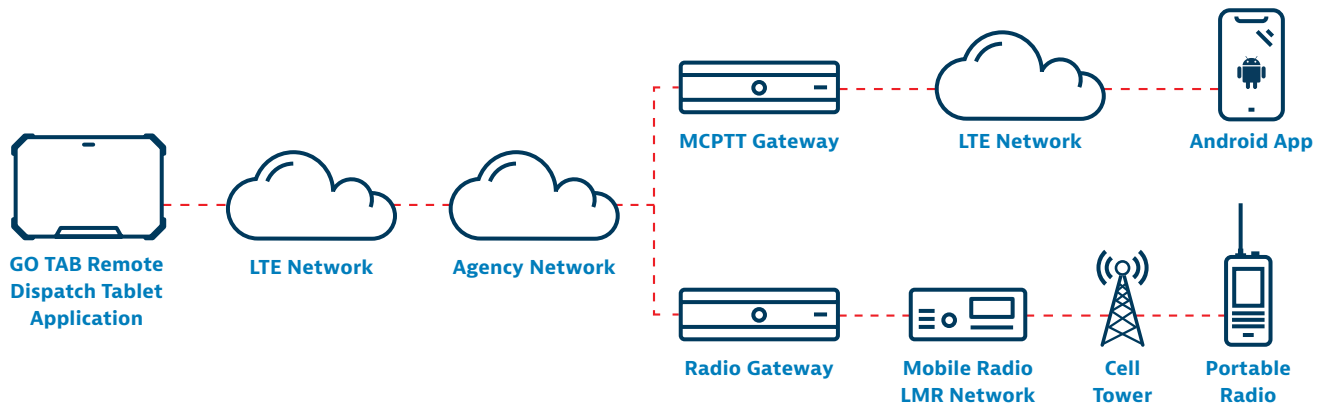
GO TAB connects these radio networks securely, using VPN technology through a Wi-Fi connection to the Internet or over wireless networks through CradlePoint LTE routers.
