

Linc MCPTT - Overview



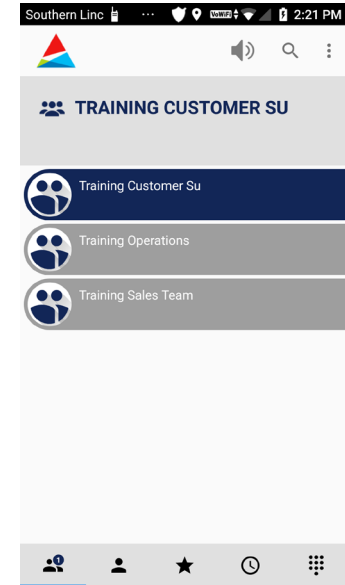
App Opening

Linc MCPTT brings a new level of push to talk performance to users.

Once downloaded, a single icon can be found in your apps. This icon replaces the four apps required by the former PTT app.

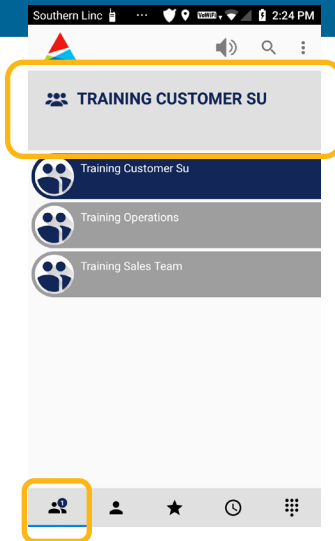


This is the new Linc MCPTT app icon

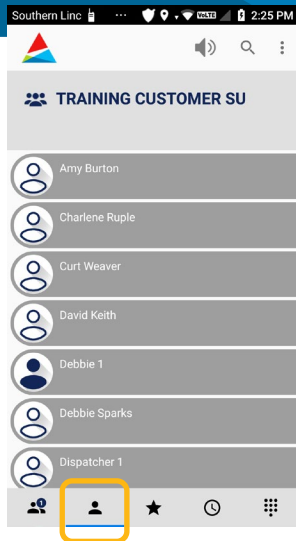


This is what the first screen of the app looks like (after setup) when you open it

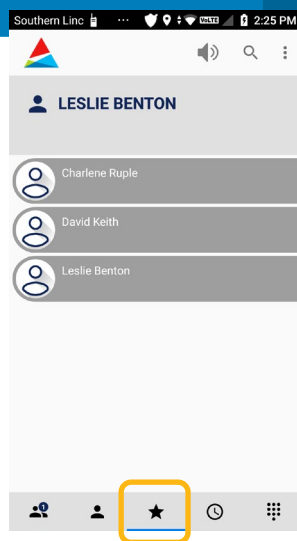
App Tab Overview



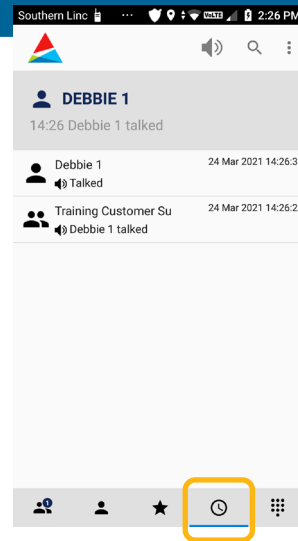
There are tabs in the ribbon at the bottom of the screen. The app opens to the “Groups” tab shown in the lower left. This tab allows you to select predefined groups to talk with. At the top of the screen is the “Target Box, or Call Box.” It shows the group or contact you will communicate with if you make a PTT call. The Target box will change color to indicate an active call.



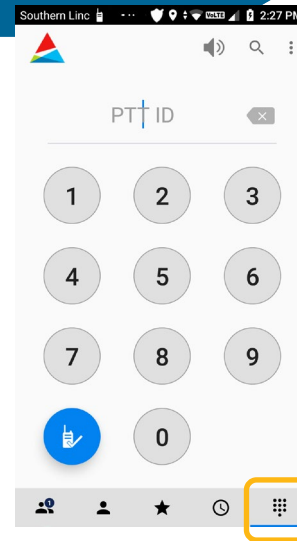
This is the “Contacts” tab, used to talk with individuals



This is the “Favorites” tab, where all your “starred” Contacts and Groups will appear.



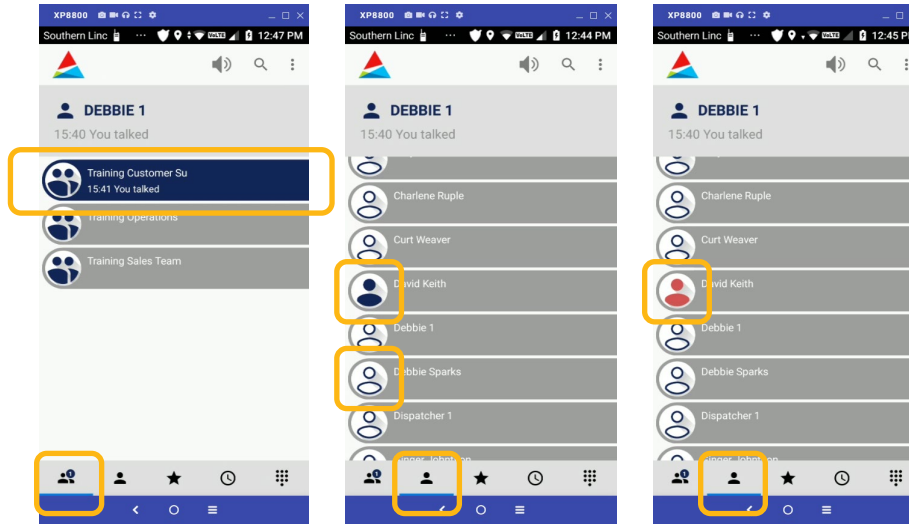
This is the “History” tab, where recordings of your MCPTT conversations appear



This is the “Dialer” tab, where you can type in a Southern Linc phone number to begin an MCPTT call.

Color indicators

Colors in the MCPTT app help you understand what groups or people are available for an MCPTT call.



Dark Blue in the Groups tab means you are actively following this group

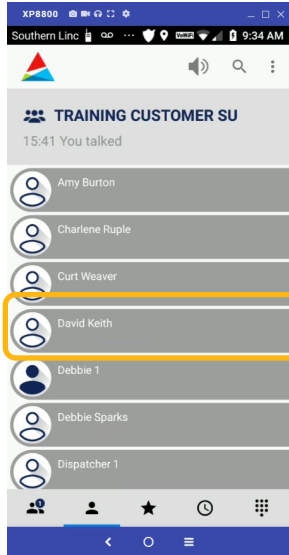
Dark Blue icon in the Contacts tab means the person is available for an MCPTT call.

A Red icon in the Contacts tab means the user is in Do Not Disturb mode

An icon without color means the contact is not available for a call.

Contacts Subnav – PTT Call and Favorites

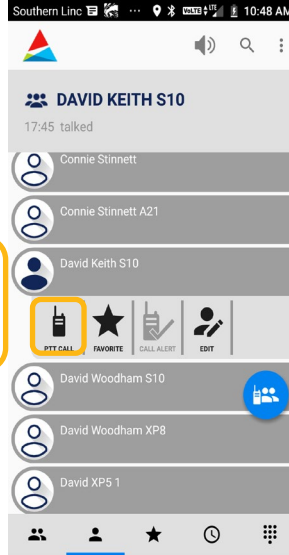
When you touch a Group or Contact, a sub navigation bar appears offering you the ability to Start or End a call, label the Group or Contact as a Favorite, send a PTT Call Request Alert, or edit Contact information. These are screens for the Contacts tab. All functions work the same way in the groups tab.



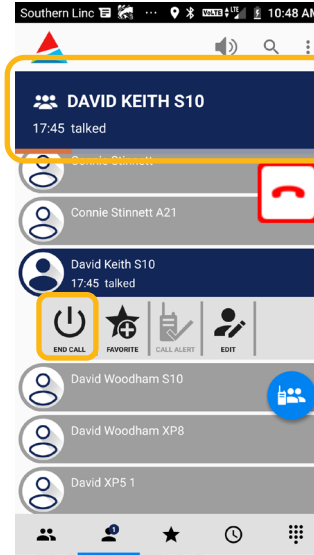
Touch a contact...



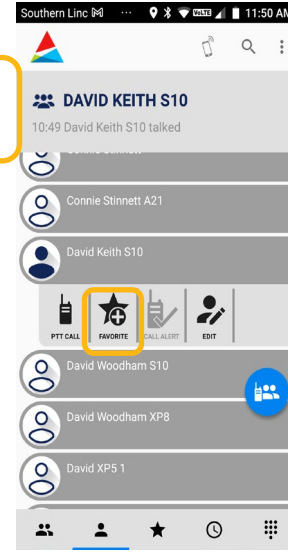
A sub nav bar opens. You can start a call, label the contact as a favorite, send a PTT call request alert or edit Contact information



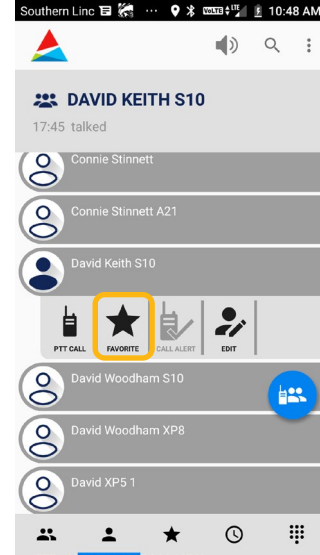
Touch the PTT Call icon to begin a call or press the PTT button on the side of your phone.



Your Target Box will turn blue and an orange bar will indicate the call is in progress. End the call by touching the End Call icon or the app will end the call after a few seconds of inactivity.

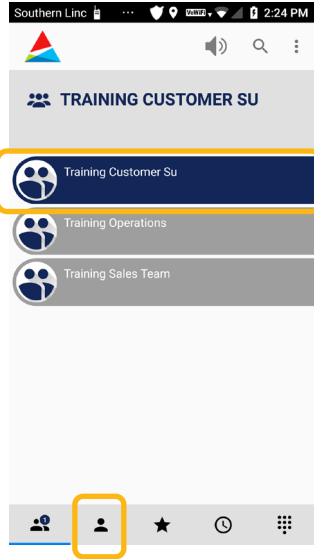


To save a contact to your Favorites list, touch the Star icon with the plus.



The Plus symbol disappears showing that this Contact is now one of your Favorites. To remove it from your Favorites list, touch the icon again and the + will reappear.

Making a Call – Call Alert

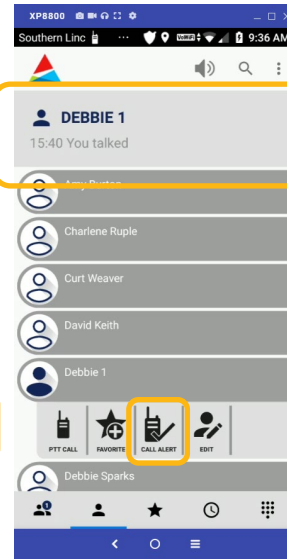


Touch the Linc MCPTT icon to open the app.

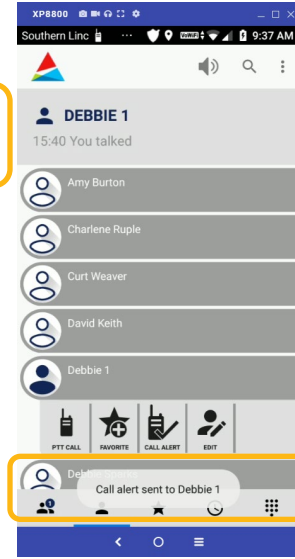
To make an MCPTT call to an individual, touch the Contacts icon at the bottom of the app screen.



Scroll through your list of Contacts and touch the name of the Contact you want to talk with. That name will appear in the "Target Box". (This assumes the "Short Press on Contact/Personal Groups selects it as target" setting is ON)



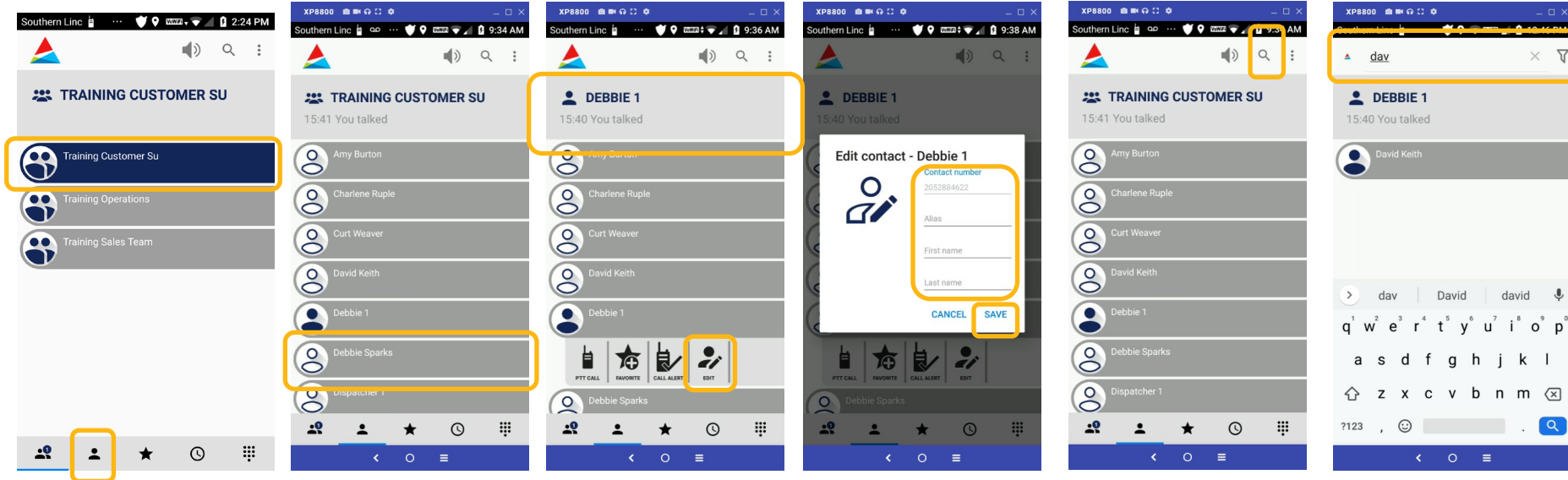
If you touch the Call Alert icon in the subnav, it sends an alert to the contact's phone. Your recipient can accept the alert and start a call with you or your alert can be canceled or ignored.



Here's the message you'll see after the Call Alert is sent.

Contacts Subnav –Editing a Contact and Searching for a Contact

Search for a Contact:



From the Linc MCPTT main screen, touch the Contacts icon at the bottom of the app screen.

Scroll through your list of Contacts and touch the name of the Contact you want to update. That name will appear in the “Target Box”. (This assumes the “Short Press on Contact/Personal Groups selects it as target” setting is ON)

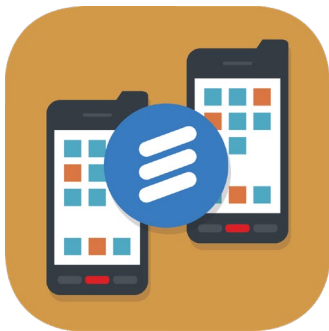
Touch the Edit icon to update your Contact’s information

This screen appears which allows to change contact info. Touch SAVE to update the information.

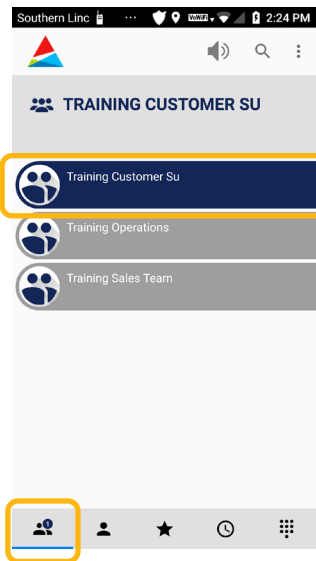
To select a Contact for an MCPTT call, you can scroll through your list or you can use the search tool at the top of the screen. Click on the magnifying glass to open the search.

A keypad opens. Begin to enter the contact name and a list of contacts matching the letters you enter will appear. Touch a name to select them for a call. Touch the X to close the Search.

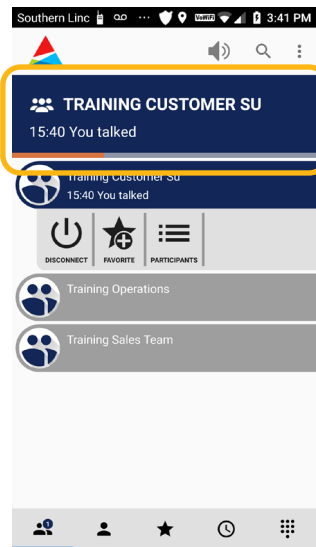
Making a Call - Group



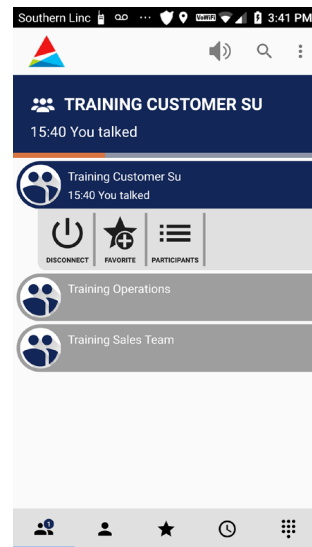
Touch the Linc MCPTT icon to open the app.



To make a group call, scroll through your list of Groups and long press the name of the group you want to talk with.

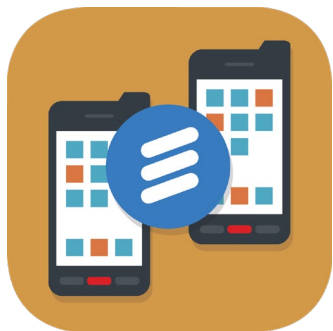


Press the PTT button on your phone to engage the call. Your group will be placed in the "Target Box" at the top of your screen and you will see an orange bar showing your call is in progress.

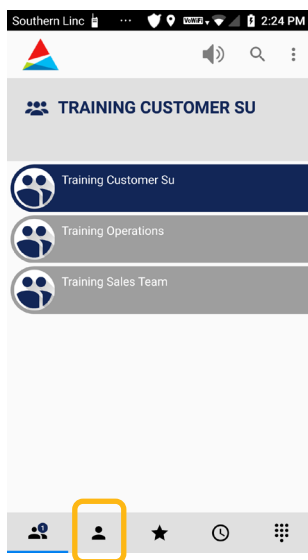


The call will end after a few seconds inactivity.

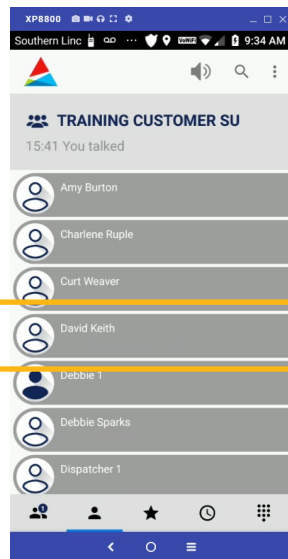
Making a Call – Individual Contact



Touch the Linc MCPTT icon to open the app.



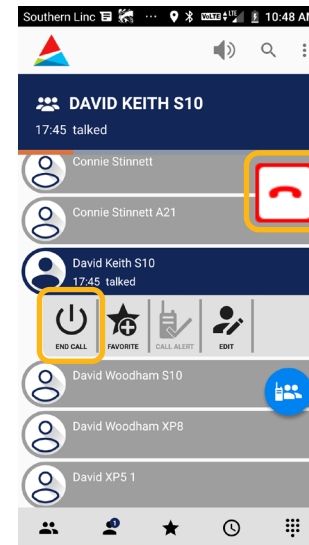
To make an MCPTT call to an individual, touch the Contacts icon at the bottom of the app screen.



Scroll through your list of Contacts and touch the name of the Contact you want to talk with. That name will appear in the “Target Box”. (This assumes the “Short Press on Contact/Personal Groups selects it as target” is ON)



Press the PTT button on the side of your phone or on your screen to start the call.



You will see an orange bar showing your call is in progress. Press the “End Call” icon to end the call or let the app end the call after a few seconds of inactivity.
